What ELEVATE looks like ...

- Students come to the program Monday-Thursday
- Hours are 3:15-6:15
- Daily schedule: 30 minutes of reading tutoring, 30 minutes of assisted homework, 45 minutes of Youth Development using the Freedom Schools Model and/or literacy, art, and music activities, and 30 minutes of physical activity.
- Daily meals are provided by Children's Hunger Alliance and the Center of Hope Kid's Supper Club program provides nutritious snacks including fresh fruits and vegetables.
- Students attended 74% of the time. The goal was 70%.
